Year 1 Homework at Archibald

We are writing to let you know about homework in Year 1 for 2026-27.

The aims of the homework are:

- To consolidate learning in school.
- To promote cooperation between home and school in supporting each child's learning.
- To help you gain a better understanding of what your child has been learning about at school

Expectations and Routines:

Homework will be sent out on a **Friday**.

Homework is to be uploaded to SeeSaw by the **following Wednesday**.

Each child has been provided with a **unique QR code** that they will need to log in to their new SeeSaw account.

All completed homework should be uploaded to SeeSaw.

All homework will be acknowledged. Homework will not be marked in depth. Common misconceptions will be addressed in class with the children.

If you have a query about homework, we ask that you come into school and discuss it with the teacher in person. Whilst we encourage you to record comments regarding your child's understanding and completion of the task, please note that SeeSaw should not be seen as a means of communication between home and school.

Homework:

Reading: We strongly encourage children to read on a daily basis, both school reading books and books of their own choice, to further develop their love of books and reading.

A reading book will be given to your child each week on a **Tuesday** for your child to read at home. Please read this book three times to help your child build up their fluency and expression which in turn builds confidence and enjoyment in reading. This book must be returned to school on a **Monday** so that a new book can be issued.

Lost Little Wandle Books must be replaced with a new copy which can be purchased via Amazon or by covering the cost of the book £5 at the school office.

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All children will also access our Year 1 library on a Friday where they will select a book of their choice that they can read for pleasure at home. This must be returned before a new book will be issued. Please record any reading at home in your child's reading diary. This should include the book brought home weekly as well as any other books you share together.

The Archibald Reading Challenge: We are pleased to launch our Archibald Reading Challenge with our 'recommended reads' for each year group. Your child will come home with a book list and a record sheet. The aim is to see how many of these books they can read before the end of July. Please record and sign on the sheet provided. We will be giving out certificates at the end of each term so do return the record sheet once your child achieves their first goal.

Good luck and happy reading!

Maths: – weekly: This will be a piece of maths work or challenge that will be linked to the work that the children have completed in school. It may be a piece of written work, a problem-solving activity, practical experience or mental maths work to support your child's mathematical knowledge and understanding of numbers.
