I am hoping to start a **'Lively Languages' club for KS1** this term (up to Easter) to allow the children to both develop their language-learning skills (which will help with their German lessons) and also to increase their cultural awareness of other countries.

Within the sessions we will look first at different countries in Europe – beginning this term with France and Spain. The children will have the opportunity to learn simple words and phrases, but mainly have fun with the language! There will be stories, games and songs in these different languages, with a focus also on cultural experiences (food tasting, watching videos about life in other countries, learning how others live etc.) The club will be lively and exciting and will hopefully get the children enthusiastic about foreign languages!

The club will take place on a Monday evening from 3.15-4.00pm, starting next Monday 4th February. It will be open to all Year 1 and Year 2 children, although numbers will need to be limited to 15 children so it will be first come first served.
