Literacy

Reading

We continue to have a love of books in Early Years and this half term is no exception.

- We will be sharing our Core Texts, retelling them and talking about our favourite parts.
- We will use stories linked to celebrations.
- Our Reading areas are cosy and the children will get chance to share some of the stories we have had already across Early Years.
- Reception children will be voting for their favourite story out of two at our Story Voting Area.
- We will be discussing authors and their important role in our lives.
- We will be sorting fiction and non-fiction books.

Writing

- We will be really encouraging our children to hold their pencils in a comfortable and effective way and ensuring they are using Tommy Thumb and Peter Pointer fingers to help.
- We will continue to enjoy Dough Disco.
- Reception will begin to complete some formal handwriting using Nelson Handwriting scheme. A handwriting activity book will be sent home for you to support your child with this.
- Reception children are working on writing simple words to match pictures using their phonic knowledge.
- Nursery will be exploring mark making in a variety of ways.

Phonics

- Nursery children will be beginning to blend sounds in words in their play as well as listening for the first sound in a word and trying to name objects beginning with this sound.
- Reception children will continue to learn new phonemes and graphemes following the Little Wandle Phonic programme.

Maths

- In Nursery we will be concentrating on saying, recognising and counting numbers to 5
- We will be sharing number rhymes
- Playing with shapes, measures and early mathematical language
- In Reception we will continue to have maths activities and language in our play
- We will be introducing 0.
- We will be looking at numbers up to 10
- We will begin to explore how these numbers are made

We always enjoy Numberblocks so we will watch our Numberblocks wall grow and enjoy watching some episodes to support our learning.

<u>PSED, Communication and Language</u> <u>Knowledge and Understanding of the World</u>

This half term our topic is called Our World! And links with day/night, environments, where we live.

- We will be investigating different continents/places inking with a variety of stories and comparing these environments with where we live
- Exploring Non-fiction books.
- Getting creative with designing and making and exploring colour with Piet Mondrian
- We will return to our work on celebrations looking at Lunar New Year.
- We will be exploring the languages in our class
- Continuing to work on our sharing and turn taking
- Continuing to building on our friendships
- We will continue our visits to Forest School—using our senses to explore our environment
