Oops, it appears we have been so busy that this is the first newsletter of the summer term. We have a few updates for you below, a request for a form to be completed and TWO competitions for you to enter

Everyone - Free School Meals

We are asking EVERYONE to complete the form to apply for Free School Meals, so Newcastle City Council can assess whether your child and the school can receive this extra help. This can help to pay towards the cost of trips for your child and any support received in school.

If you are eligible for free school meals, vouchers are issued during holiday times for the supermarket of your choice!

Newcastle City Council operates an Apply Once process for Free School Meals. During your child's academic life, you will only ever have to apply once for Free School Meals while they attend a Newcastle school.

If your application is refused, they will continue to check your details on a weekly basis, unless you tell them to stop. This means we will know if you start to get a qualifying benefit. They will approve your child's free school meals application and contact you.

<u>Please remember to add younger siblings on as they join school too!</u>

If you apply through the online portal, you will receive an immediate response to your application. School will be informed of your child's Free School Meal application on a weekly basis.

Suncream

Sunscreen should be applied to areas of exposed skin that are not covered by clothing to protect it from Ultraviolet Radiation. Without adequate protection, a child's delicate skin can easily burn, causing cumulative and irreparable damage. This can significantly increase their risk of developing skin cancer in later life.

Sunscreen must be provided by the parents/carers and should be:

- Labelled 'Broad-Spectrum' to provide protection against both UVA and UVB.
- A minimum Sun Protection Factor (SPF) 30
- Checked to ensure it is still within its expiry date
- Applied liberally before school by parents/carers

As 12-hour sun-screen is now widely available on the market, school recommends that this is used by our families prior to the school day.

Children can bring in their own sunscreen to reapply during the day. This should be a labelled bottle and kept in their bag. They must be able to apply this themselves and must not share their cream with other children. If they have their own sun screen in school, this can be reapplied at the start of the lunch break only.

No staff member will apply children's sunscreen directly for any year group.

Summer School Uniform and Shoes

Summer dresses – red qingham – can be worn in the warmer months.



If sandals are worn, they must be plain in colour — white, red, blue or black. They must be flat, fasten securely around ankles and socks MUST be worn to protect toes!!!

Crocs, flip flops, slip on and heels cannot be worn!

For anyone wearing hairbands and bobbles, these should be low key. We love the bows and the 'ears' but please keep these for home!!

Free Food Boxes

We are working with a company called Feeding Families who provides prepacked boxes of food. They supply boxes which would feed 2 people for 3-5 days. The boxes are filled with ambient food which does not require refrigeration and foods usually have a shelf life of a month minimum. E.g. 19 to 20 items such as UHT milk, canned goods, cereal...
